Moving forward I will be focused on resolving all Art Center commitments.

For those of you who have made advance payments for spring tuition or Monday open studio participation, I will be refunding your money. I have some of your addresses but it will help me considerably if you will email me your current mailing address at scarpenter43@yahoo.com.

I will be moving artwork stored here toward the front by the entrance to allow you to pick up your artwork without going beyond the very front of the studio. I will generally be here in the mornings until early afternoon but please call in advance to insure access (469-0702). When everything is out front and ready for pickup and coronavirus related conditions allow, I will provide an update. My health and age make me especially vulnerable to the coronavirus so I will not be able

to greet you at the studio as much as I might like to. I hope you can understand.

Since I will be cleaning out the studio there will be items which I can't use but which may be of use elsewhere. The process of getting organized will take some time. I will send progress updates which will include what items will be available and when.

Hi LaShonda!

Reaching out to confirm with you for next week's figure drawing session. It will be Wednesday 3/18 from 6-8pm at The Yards. I suggest bringing a robe, a sheet, and a water bottle.

Since this will be your first time modeling for us, I'll get you familiar with the structure of the evening. It's pretty relaxed! We usually begin with a few short poses for gestural warm-ups, ranging from 1-5 minutes, then go on to 15 and 20 minute poses, and end with a 45 minute pose. I'll keep time and always notify you how long is left per pose and how long the next pose will be. But other than that it's up to you! I'll ask the room if anyone has requests for a pose they'd like to draw, very occasionally is there a request, but sometimes. Take as many breaks as you want! Your comfort is important. No photos are allowed. You can change in the bathroom or my studio, which has a door and locks and you can leave your belongings in my studio. Arriving 5-10 minutes early leaves plenty of time usually to get ready.
